

## Services

### **School place offering**

We are able to accommodate individual students into our school on a cost per student basis for KS3/KS4 and a cost per subject for KS5.

### **School classroom offering – single student cohort**

We are able to provide a dedicated classroom for up to 18 students providing a full KS3 curriculum or KS4 curriculum where students can study up to 11 IGCSE courses.

If you wish for your students to study in a dedicated online school environment, branded to your requirements this can be provided at an additional one-off charge.

### **School classroom offering – class places occupied by multiple students**

You may wish to secure a number of school places or dedicated classroom where you expect a single place to be occupied by more than one student across a year; this can be accommodated with a simple charging structure per seat or class with a small additional fee for every student who takes up place at the school.

### **Core subject support**

We are also able to deliver a specific curriculum designed to your requirements; this may focus on numeracy or literacy support and may be a term's study that is repeated across the year.

### **Flexible student placing**

In specific circumstances we are able to accommodate students on a 'per student per hour' basis.

### **General**

Students would receive weekly homework assignments that would be marked with full feedback. Student progress would be constantly monitored and formally assessed every half-term with feedback provided. Students would be contacted daily in addition to each class registration to ensure that they are happily engaged in their studies.

For all services detailed above, we will provide a monthly report detailing progress. In addition we would undertake a minimum of termly review meetings with interspersed virtual meetings/conference calls to monitor progress.
